LR Kennel Club offering full obedience school scholarship for an articulate young handler's dog

MEREDITH — Scholarships for dogs? Why not?

That's what the Lakes Region Kennel Club thought recently. Dogs love to be trained. Their humans love to interact with them. Together they make a great team. Dog lovers have discovered this many times as they train their dogs at obedience classes.

Following the successful celebration of Responsible Dog Owner's Day last summer at the Belknap Mall, members of the Kennel Club were impressed by the sincere interest demonstrated by many young people in the welfare of their friends. Cathy Bourne, president of the local Kennel Club, said that was when the organization decided to increase its support of juniors by teaching them how to become responsible dog owners as adults. If they experience the joys of pet interaction and proper care of animals when they are young, they will have a lifetime of unforgettable pet companionship.

The Kennel Club holds obedience classes on a regular basis at the Meredith Community Center. The next class for beginning students will start Wednesday, May 21. The Club has announced that this year

it will offer a full scholarship to a qualifying pooch and its junior boy or girl handler for the series of six lessons in beginner obedience training.

According to Marjorie Wessner, a board member of the Kennel Club, the rules will be simple. A boy or girl between the ages of 11 and 16 years of age may be considered a junior handler of a dog who is over four months old. There is no maximum age for the dog. The Club believes no dog is too old to learn basic obedience commands. Any breed is acceptable. Dogs must not have a history of aggressiveness towards humans or other dogs, up-to-date rabies shots, and youth handlers must be accompanied by an adult at all lessons.

Selection of the scholarship recipient will be made on the basis of a paragraph of approximately 250 words written by the junior handler, explaining why he or she wants to train their dog into obedience.
